

# 2022-2023 Competition Dates and Subjects

### 29 September 2022 Round 1 Open Subject (PDI/Print)

Any subject matter is acceptable but must be your own work.

## 27 October 2022 Round 2 Abandoned/Decay (PDI/Print)

Subject matter must predominantly showcase something neglected, abandoned, and/or in a state of decay

### 24 November 2022 Round 3 Open Subject (PDI/Print)

Any subject matter is acceptable but must be your own work.

#### 15 December 2022 Round 4 Scapes – Land, Sea, City or Sky (PDI/Print)

Entries must predominantly showcase a Landscape, Seascape, Cityscape or Skyscape

### 12 January 2023 Phil Atkinson Trophy

PDI Only

The five subjects have been decided by the winner of the 2020/21 competition and are listed below Subjects

- It's Only Rock and Roll (but I like it): ICM images that involve intentional camera movement over extended exposure time to achieve an Impressionist/surreal look.
- **Staying Alive**: Street/Urban photography that involves human interaction with the built environment (no beggars or homeless)
- So Lonely: A single human figure made small within a large landscape setting
- We Gotta Get Out of this Place: Ugly/Grotesque Architecture (inside or out)
- Join Together: images of musician(s) playing/ singing/performing

## 2 February 2023 Creative Digital Creative (PDI Only)

This competition is for you to get creative - manipulation of images is a must, but any images or textures etc must be your own. You can use effects / brushes you have created. You are allowed to use the effects / brushes that come built into the software you are using but not any you may have purchased and added to the software.

#### 30 March 2023 Round 5 Open Subject (Print/Print)

Any subject matter is acceptable but must be your own work.

## 27 April 2023 Round 6 Reflections (PDI/Print)

Entries must predominantly showcase Reflections, e.g. Mirrors, Water

#### 25 May 2023 Annual Open (PDI/Print)

Open Subject and all images should be taken between May 2022 and April 2023 Scoring for this competition is via a members vote. The judge will only give his opinion but not any marks.
