

## **MKCPS Phil Atkinson Versatility Challenge**

- 1. The Phil Atkinson Versatility Challenge is a projected digital image competition separate from all other internal club competitions.
- 2. The competition will consist of five rounds with each round having a different set subject.
- 3. The set subjects for each of the five rounds will be announced two weeks before the competition.
- 4. The closing date for submission of entries will be one week before the competition.
- 5. Participating members must enter an image in each of the five rounds.
- 6. Images entered to the competition are to come from the members own supply of 'stock' images and;
  - a) Will have been taken before the subjects are announced.
  - b) Copyright of the entered image must be held by the member submitting them
  - c) Evidence may be required to show that it was taken before the announcement of the subjects.
  - d) Images may have been entered in previous internal competitions or may be new work not shown before.
- 7. Digital images for projection should be submitted using PhotoEntry.
- 8. Entries must comply to the following requirements:
  - a) The image size must be no larger than 1600 pixels wide by 1200 pixels high.
  - b) Images must be saved in JPEG format and in the sRGB colour space.
  - c) Images uploaded using PhotoEntry only requires a title. PhotoEntry will ensure that the title uses upper case letters. The title must not include your name and must not contain any punctuation (e.g. apostrophes, hyphens etc.).
  - d) Image titles should be a maximum of 28 characters in length.
- 9. The images will be scored out of 20.
- 10. The winner will be the member with the highest aggregate score on the night.
- 11. The winner will choose the subjects and judge the competition the following year.
